## 2024 CHILD/PARENT CONTRACT TO BE COMPLETED, SIGNED AND SUBMITTED TO THE LOCAL ASSOCIATION

### FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY AND PARENTAL/PARTICIPANT CONSENT

1. As parent/guardian of the above-named child, I do hereby give my/our approval for participation in Shenango Valley Midget Football League (TYAC) activities for the current season. I/We understand that the training and supervision of football and cheerleading activities are provided by volunteers. Head Coaches are expected to train and supervise their staff to reduce the incidence of injury, and to respond promptly to emergencies. Not only do I/we acknowledge this situation, I/We assume all risks and hazards to this participation for any claims arising out of injury to the above-named child, including, but not limited to, transportation to and from such activities. I/We hereby waive, release, absolve, indemnify and agree to hold harmless, all volunteers of the league, local team, organizers, managers, coaches, supervisors, participants, persons providing transportation, all organizations which provide this program the use of their facilities, and all other organizations which this youth football program may be affiliated with.

2. There have been many improvements made in protective equipment and teaching techniques to reduce injuries. Even so, it is important for you to know that injuries can occur. In executing the foregoing release, I/We acknowledge that I/We understand that our personal medical/dental insurance will remain the primary carrier, and that any insurance covering school facilities is secondary in nature and is subject to an annual deductible by the carrier. It is understood that any claim for injury arising out of my/our child's participation must be reported to the TYAC board within 30 days of the date of injury. It is also understood that the proof of loss must be completed in full and filed within 60 days of receipt by TYAC. All monies I/We have paid to the team do not constitute payment of insurance coverage. I/We do indemnify TYAC, the team association, and the insurance carrier should there be statement(s) by anyone that is in contradiction. I/We attest I/We have read and understand the terms of this contract and any disclosure information required.

3. I/We understand that my player/cheerleader will not be allowed to participate in any TYAC activities until our local Team has on file a physical dated and signed by a physician not earlier than January 1 of the current league year, a copy of their birth certificate, and both pages of this completed and signed contract.

4. I/We hereby grant authority to a qualified physician to administer such medical treatment, as said physician deems necessary under emergency circumstances in my/our absence. This authorization shall remain effective until the end of the season unless sooner revoked in writing delivered to my Team officials.

5. I/We have read and understand fully the provisions of this consent/release authorization, and I/We have voluntarily signed it.

## 2024 ADULT CODE OF ETHICS TO BE COMPLETED, SIGNED AND SUBMITTED TO THE LOCAL ASSOCIATION

The Shenango Valley Midget Football League (TYAC) is a non-profit volunteer organization, which instills to inspire youth to practice the ideals of sportsmanship, scholarship, and physical fitness, as well as to bring area youth closer together through the means of a common interest in sportsmanship, scholarship, fellowship, and athletic competition. These goals could not be achieved without the participation and cooperation of parents, guardians, and other adult and youth volunteers. You play an important part in the league even if you do not coach or volunteer your time. Good sportsmanship is a concept that is understood by many and practiced by too few. Adult misbehavior at youth sporting events is something that has gained national attention and has served to undermine youth sports in this country.

### “Children Grow Up to Become What They Learn”

As the parent or legal guardian of a child within the TYAC, I hereby consent to abide and ensure that my child will abide by all the rules, guidelines, policies and directives established by the Team and League of which my child may be a participant. Additionally, I will, to the best of my ability, attempt to ensure that members of **my family, my friends and any of my relatives** who may be directly or indirectly participating in Team or League activities, will also abide by all the rules, guidelines, policies, and directives established by the Team or League, of which my child will be a participant.

I understand that I may be asked to leave the premises of a Team or League activity if, in the judgment of a Team or League official, my behavior, including any friends/family I am with, is deemed to be; inconsistent with the goals and philosophies of the Team or League; is not in the best interest of the children, parents, spectators, etc., who may be directly or indirectly participating in a Team or League activity; or if my behavior is abusive, degrading, or cause harm or injury to people around me.

A single violation can result in that spectator/parent being removed from the field and being banned from all future games or practices by TYAC teams for the remainder of the season/one year. Failure to leave as requested or even attending any following game or practice will result in removal by the local law enforcement agency.

1. I understand that children learn best by example and that I will always attempt to set a good example for my child and any other children who participate or have any involvement within the TYAC.
2. I will teach my child that victory is important, and that honesty and hard work are equally rewarding.
3. I will teach my child that one individual cannot win a team competition.
4. I will teach and demonstrate by example the importance of good sportsmanship in victory and in defeat.
5. I will not publicly question the honesty, integrity, or judgment of the volunteer coaches or other adult volunteers.
6. I will in no way criticize, demean, belittle, mock, taunt or attempt to communicate with any Team or League REFEREE, before, during, or after a game/activity.
7. I will respect a Team or League official's right NOT to communicate with me "on the spur of the moment" about issues that may be potentially controversial, or, under the circumstance, not in the immediate best interests of the child participants.
8. As a Parent, Guardian, or Spectator, I will responsibly handle disagreements. I agree not to engage in divisive activities such as verbal and physical confrontation. I will not create conflict by slander, malicious rumors, or threats. Nor will I entice another to do so. I agree to submit any complaints to my local organization first, and to the board of the TYAC as a last resort. Complaints to the TYAC board must be in writing (postal mail, or e-mail).

By signing below, I understand that if I violate this agreement, I will be subject to disciplinary action, which could include probation, suspension, and expulsion from TYAC activities.
